10.06	3	3	3	0		<p>Papers come to managing editor who "blinds" the papers. They are then sent to the two editors for consideration. A decision is made whether to reject. The majority of papers are rejected at this stage. If the paper is not rejected it is sent to referees (still blind). The editors then consider the referee reports and decide whether to publish the paper based on their reports. It is rare for editors not to follow the recommendations of referees.</p> <p><i>Tentative conclusion:</i> process is blind, at least the first time through. However, if the paper is given a revise and resubmit the editors correspond with the author so the second stage is not blind.</p>
