

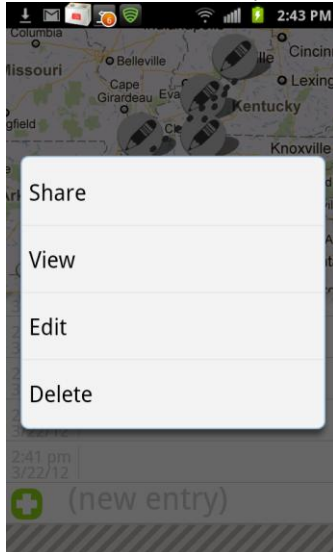

Good:

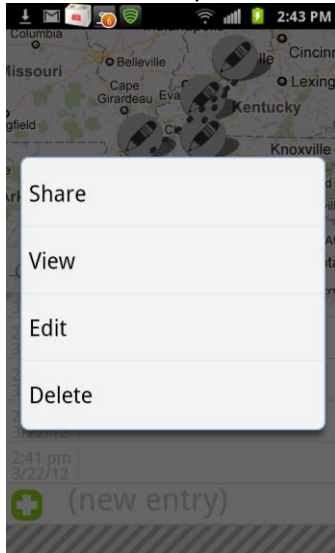
1. Consistency with button appearance: click and hold, options all look the same as one would expect from other android applications.

Heuristic: Error prevention

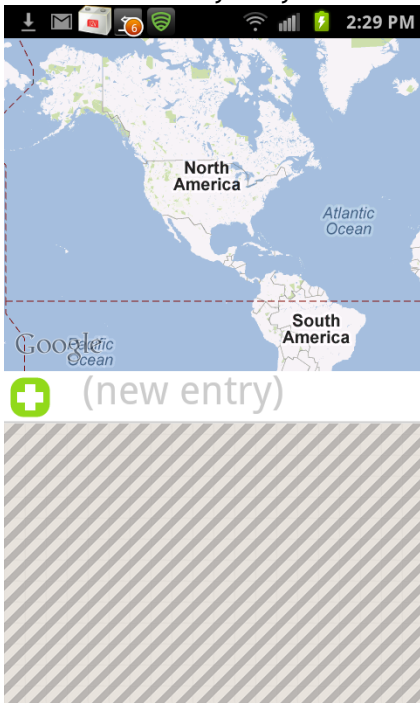


3. Implemented something for a long click and hold. We expect some options to show up there, and it is good that there was something there.

Heuristic: Consistency and standards. Same image as above.

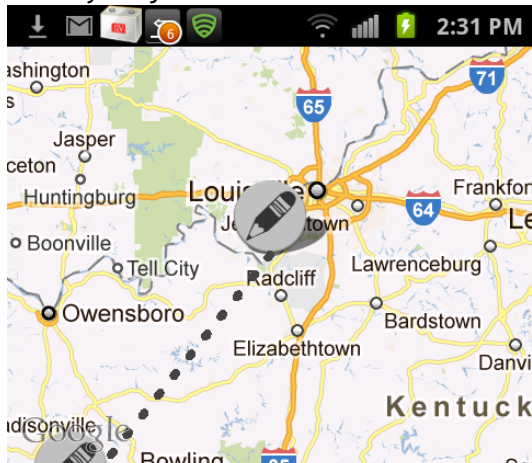
Bad

Heuristic: Visibility of System Status,

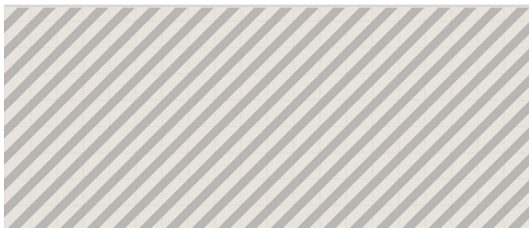

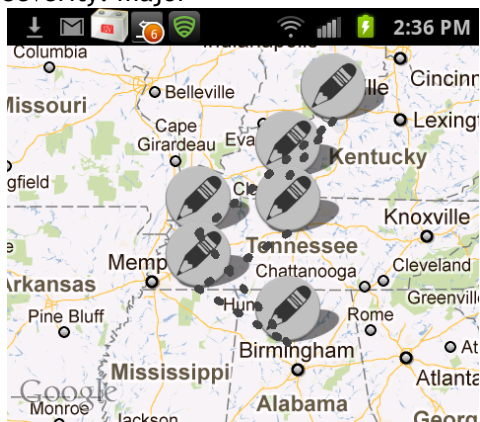

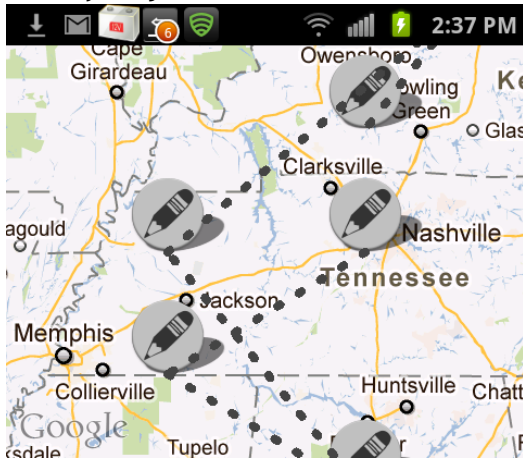


3. Zoom map in or out, or pan across map not implemented. People expect to be able to see things on the map, from previous experience with maps using the android platform.

Heuristic: Visibility of system status,

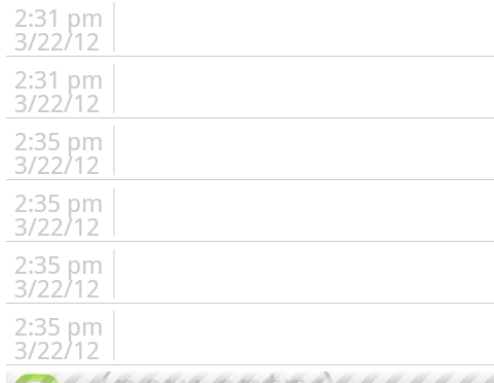
Severity: Major

Heuristics: Flexibility and efficiency of use

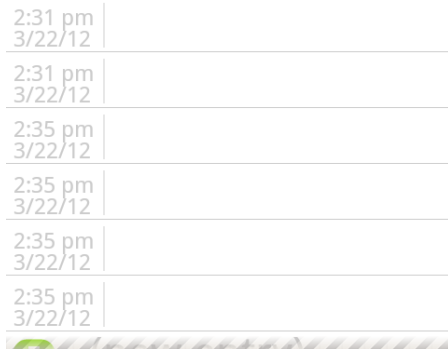
Severity: Minor

Heuristic: Flexibility and efficiency of use

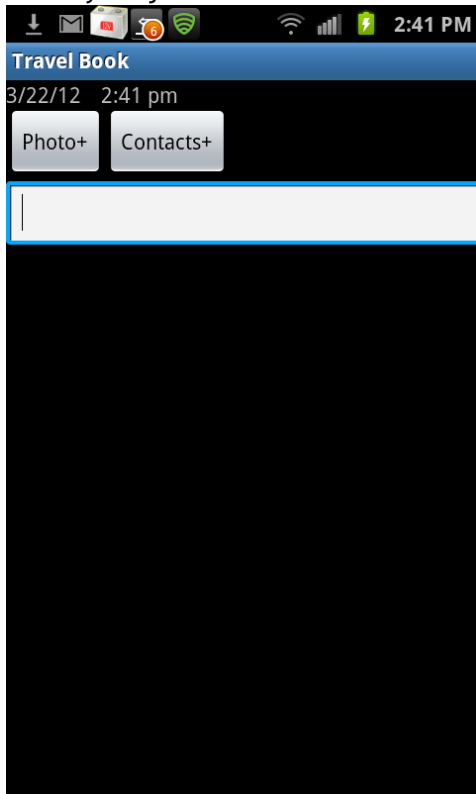
Severity: Minor

Heuristics: Recognition rather than recall, consistency and standards

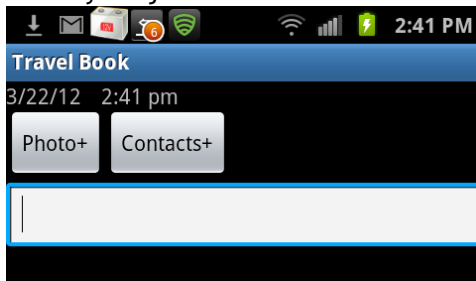
Severity: Major

Severity: Major



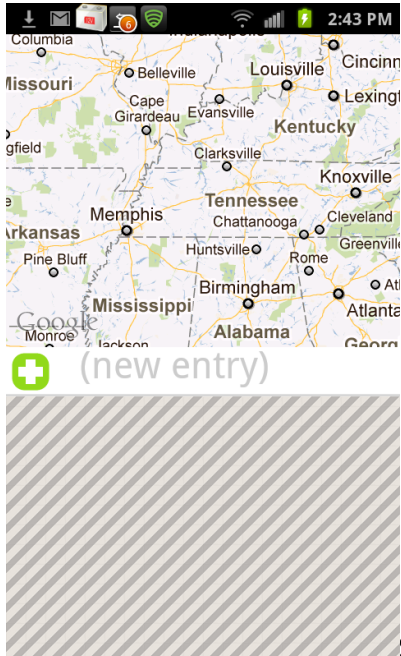
9. There is no way to cancel a new entry, as when you go back, the new entry is there already.

Screen fixed itself when I made a new entry (may just be a weird bug, did not manage to repeat) as you can see, map is zoomed into the previous location, but I have no pins.

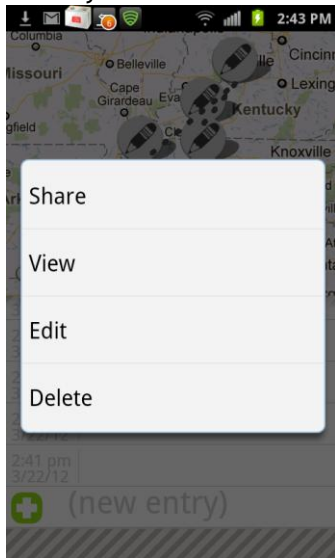
Heuristic: Match between system and the real world,

Heuristic: User control and freedom, help users recognize and diagnose, recover from errors

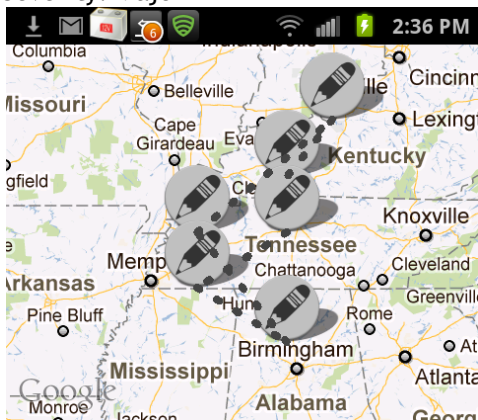
Severity: Minor



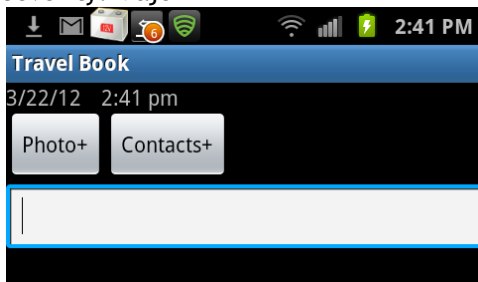
12. The date of entry wrong, off by a month.
