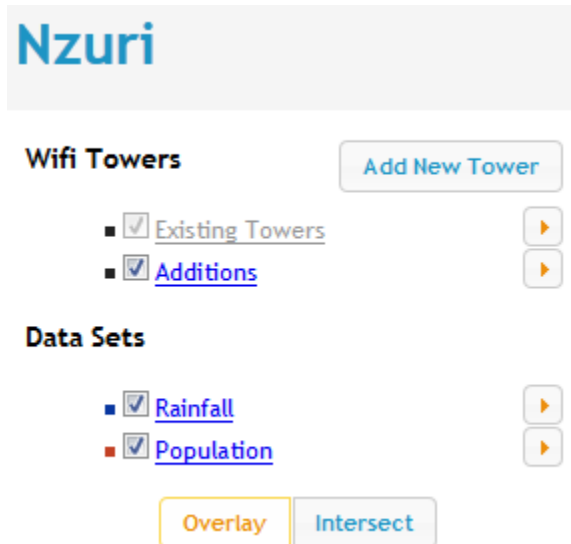
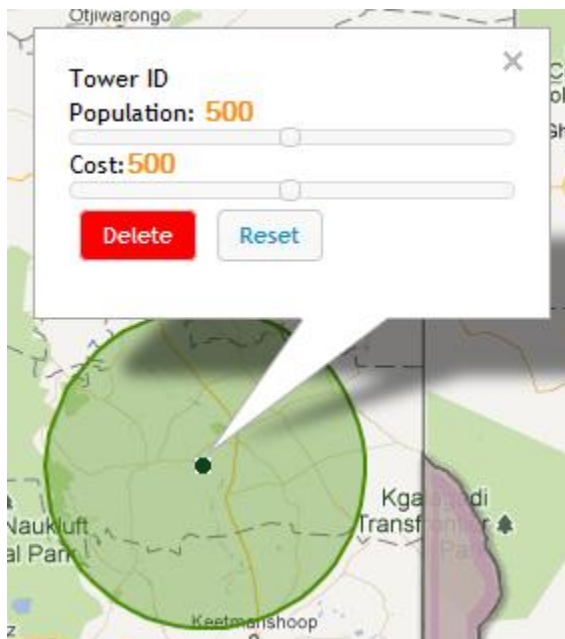


## Bad points:

- **Help and documentation:** There is not enough textual information as to what the interface is or what it does. Small descriptive sentences under each heading will be helpful in understanding what the interface does. It is a **minor** problem that can be corrected easily.

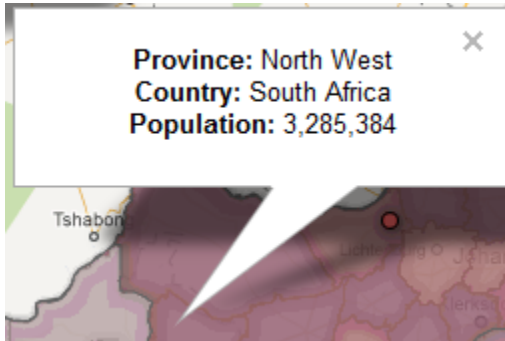


- **Error diagnosis and reporting:** A way to move a tower after placing it on the map is needed. It is vital that a user has to be able to do this otherwise it is burdensome to delete it and replace it. It is what a user would expect so not having it is a major **drawback**.

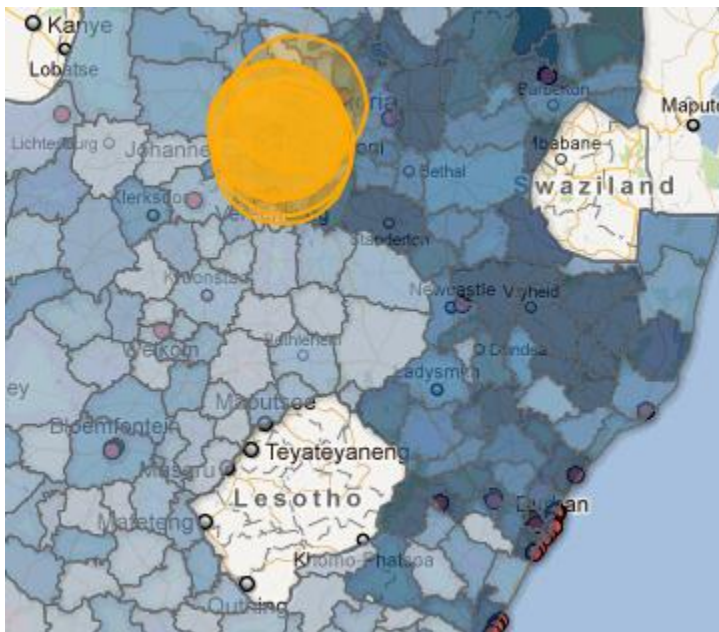


## Good points:

- **Control and freedom for placing towers:** It is good that I can place tower anywhere I want. Also, being able to get information about the province I click on is informative for placing towers where it is needed the most. It would be nice to know if an area is covered by a WIFI tower.



- **Minimalist:** The design is so simple and minimal, yet not oversimplified. It is not cluttered with random data manipulation functionalities. Although it is simple, the map is interactive and informative.
- **Use of Hue is good:** The color hue for indicating the population and rainfall is good for human perception. Although when two data sets are overlaid, two different color hues are not perceptible and very hard to distinguish from each other. For overlaying, maybe having the same color will help to show the color hue.
