Artists:

Things to Work on:

Artists:

- 1. After uploading a new picture, the user cannot see what picture they uploaded. There isn't a lot of safety if the wrong picture was uploaded. (Error Prevention Major)
- 2. In the Reviewer Group Privacy Setup, if you drop the tag into "Drag Group Name Here" box, the original box remains under the tag. It looks a little weird. (Visibility of System Status Minor)
- 3. In the Reviewer Group Privacy Setup, I'm not sure how to remove tags that I have added. Trying to drag them back to their original location doesn't seem to work. (Error Reporting, Diagnosis,

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4. In the Reviewer Group Privacy Setup, if you drop the tag into the Public or Private column, then resize the page, the tag will not be oriented correctly. This isn't a large issue as we are supposed to use it with the window maximized, just something I noticed. (Consistency and Standards - Costmetic)

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Commenters:

- 2. It might be nice for a user to know what group they are in when commenting, I don't see any label that makes the user aware of that.(Visibility of System Status Minor)
- 3. Are commenters allowed to see others comments while commenting? Or am I just the first commenter in this case. (Visibility of System Status Costmetic)

Artist Feedback:

 It can be hard to tell if a tag is selected or not. I don't think I immediately realized that tags were selected when I opened the page, so I was confused when I couldn't "select" them. Maybe more of a color change? Something to make it clear that something is in the off position or the on position.
