Icon Colors


Recognition not Recall, and Internal Consistency (Good)

All icons have a text below it which give a good information scent about what does each icon mean. Without text people tend to forget what icons mean if you use too many different icons.

Numbers over the course boxes under "Upcoming Courses" section Information Scent (Good)



Good information scent as it clearly shows how popular a course is.

Icons, Numbers, and Start Date over the course listing Information Scent (Good)




Good information scent as it clearly shows how popular a course is, what date since it's running and icon is a good indicator of what category it belongs to.

Efficiency:

Fix category menu on scroll

Efficiency (Good)



It allows users to change category without needing to scroll all the way up.

All actions under one boxes

Efficiency (Good)



Users doesn't need to look around to figure out how to see course details, videos, submit a review etc...

Filters by different categories

Efficiency (Good)



Easy to filter courses by university, course category etc...

Incremental filters on multiple items

Efficiency (Good)



Allows to add/remove filters under the same bucket. Provides efficiency.

Fitt's law (deleting a selected filter item -- target size)

Efficiency (Good)



Making the entire box clickable means target size is more so easier to click.

Safety:

Clearing/Adding filter items

User Control & Freedom (Good)



Even if a wrong filter is selected it can be removed. If it is deleted, it can be added back again -- provides users to do undo/redo.

Slider feedback (Error Prevention)

Visibility of system status (Good)



When the slider moves there is a good feedback (filled rectangle) which would prevent users from making mistakes.

Success/Failure Message

Error Message/Visibility of system status (Good)




On submitting the review, it shows submitting, on success turns green, on failure turns red.

Internal Inconsistency (Major)



How does course name, review and the category icon relate? It's not even consistent? How would I understand which review belongs to which course?

Icons disappear on hover (course category menu)

Bad Information Scent, Bad feedback (Major)



What is the rationale behind icons disappearing with empty white-spaces? It has no information scent, not a great way to give hover feedback.

No way to figure out that there are more categories (course category menu) Learnability/Discoverability (Major)



There is no way to know (until I hover) that there are more items in the category menu. May be something like "More.." would help.

Only rating & title is a bad information scent (upcoming courses)

Bad Information Scent (Minor)



I would put institute name as well as start date. You don't need the entire area be occupied by a big number. The information scent density for that space is low. Without any compromise, you achieve much more information scent.

How would user even know what date to put? I think filter by month can still be okay but I can't see how one can search by putting exact dates. Dates are difficult to remember. Searching by exact date is not at all efficient. It's not a flight search where you know exact travel dates.

The message doesn't have any link. I had to figure out how to check the resources by looking around and then I finally saw "Resources" in the nav bar. Make this text a clickable link.

Aesthetic and Design:

Redundancy (labels in filter results!)

You don't need to label "University", "Length" etc... (Minor)

It is not visible in squint test (Minor)




it doesn't stand out; gets lost with the background color.
