


## Heuristic Evaluation KaJaMi



- 1) The drag and drop feature... of the site is extremely **efficient**. I can't think of a faster way to upload music files. Very nice.
- 2) The ability to playback music ▶ 1. Tibia ...gives the user valuable **feedback** and **control** over what they are doing.
- 3) On the "My Uploads" tab, it is not clear exactly where I am supposed to drag file from, which may present a **learnability** issue. I first started dragging the file from the list of songs that were already there. I only realized afterwards that I can drag from my file System. (minor)



- 4) I did not realize that I can also drag zip files directly to the drag box (really cool!) which may also present a **learnability** issues. Some indication of what type of files can be uploaded would be a good idea. (minor)
- 5) The "Drag files here to upload" is not actually "here". In the given implementation, the window captures the drag anywhere you put it. I don't know if you specifically want it in the "drag here" box. This may

create **error** issue if the user thinks they can reconsider an upload and let the file drop in the window not on the “drag here” box. (minor)

- 6) Upon deleting marked tracks, the warning dialog box does not specify the tracks you are deleting. The user will have to look again at what they marked for deletion or might delete tracks they didn't want to delete. **(efficiency and error handling)**. (major)



- 7) The title of the warning dialog box does not inform the user of its use. **(efficiency)**. (very minor).
- 8) It would be nice if the warning dialog had a warning icon on it. **(graphic design)**. (minor)
- 9) The user had to “realize that the track sounded familiar” in order to find out that they had the same track twice. Users today would expect an application to inform them of duplicate items in a database. This will definitely pose **error handling** issues. (catastrophic)
- 10) The song description at the top does not tell the user what each field refers to. This poses **efficiency** and **error handling** issues since the user will have to somehow find out what each field refers to or will make mistakes. There might be a standard format for song descriptions that

users of the site are familiar with. You just have to make sure of that.
