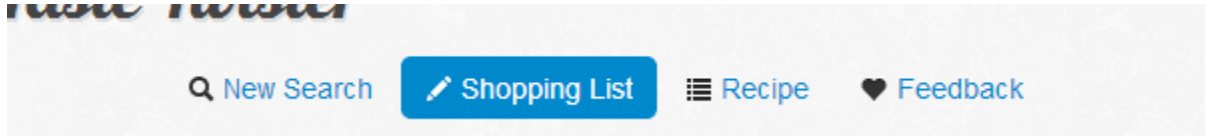


Severity: Major

1. Shopping List, Recipe, and feedback buttons not present on the main page.

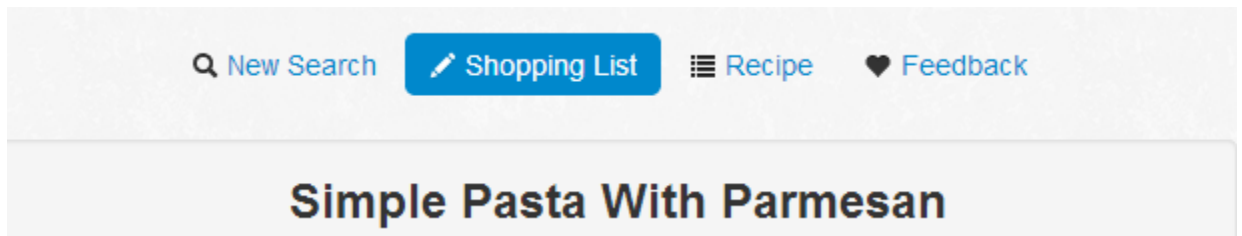
[Consistency, Efficiency, Visible Navigation]



2. When selecting a potential recipe, there is no easy way to return to the search if the user decides not to commit to that recipe.

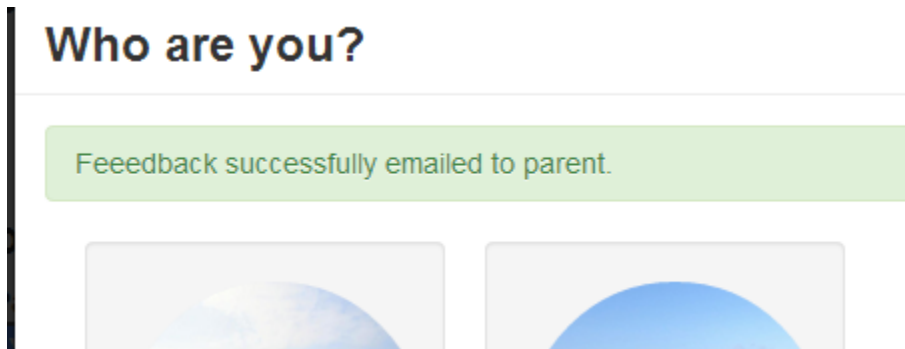
Presumably users will not select the first dish every time.

3. Vote submission feedback coincides with an irrelevant page, could just be a simple dialog that acknowledges the button press.

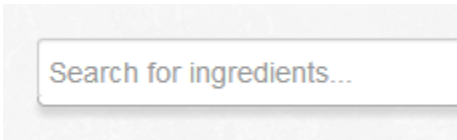

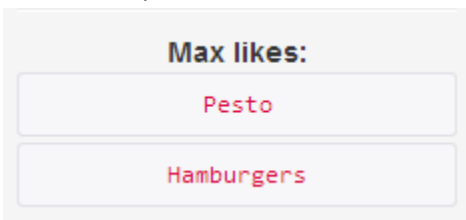
4. Says search for ingredients, but you're searching for dishes.

[Learnability, Consistency]



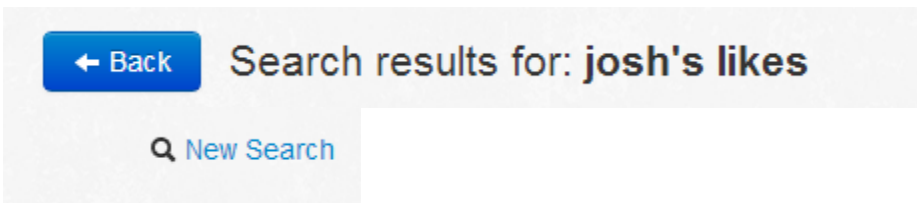
5. Liked foods/ingredients mixed and items looked clickable/interactive

7. Submitting a rating doesn't match the point scale displayed when searching.

[Consistency, User Control]



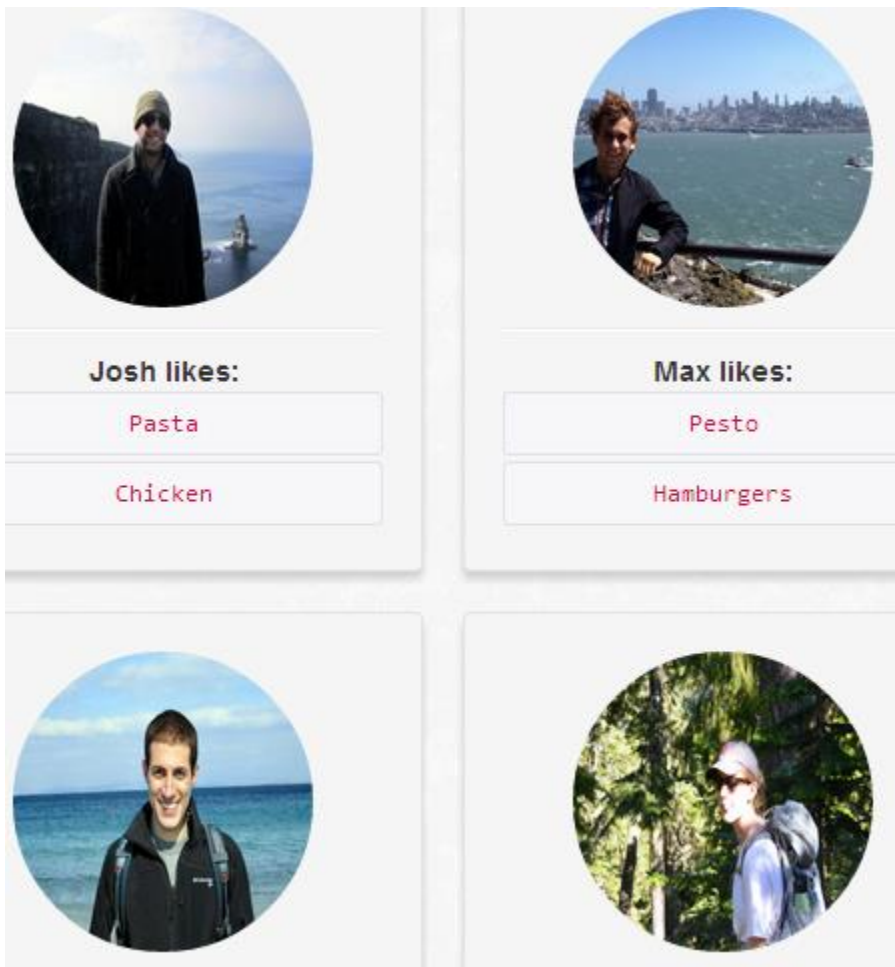
8. Amount of ingredient is kind of ambiguous here, “17 Pasta” and “9 Olive Oil” doesn’t really make sense on its own.

9. User picture seems kind of redundant/excessive when the webpage is designed for parents and their children (i.e. parents shouldn’t need a picture to recognize their children when name is provided)

10. Checkmarks contrast with strikethroughs.

Mostly a stylistic concern, although I see how checkmarks make it obvious the items are clickable. (Same concern for recipe instructions page).


11. Entire layout is centered except for title and Print / Share.




- Cook pasta according to package directions.

13. An excess of white space in the Share list; Not clear if {{Name + Email}} or {{Phone Number}}, or {{Name + {Email or Phone Number}}}.

Also not explicitly sure what phone number does, presumably text message.



It might be better to accumulate a list, and send all at once similar to the way the front page search bar works (with easily removable entries).

15. Yes/No toggles on voting wouldn't scale well to long lists of ingredients, possibly confuse whether the switch is for the above or below ingredient. Also applies to skipping through the list to mark a certain ingredient at a glance.

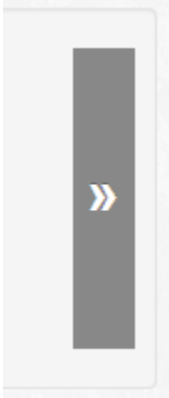

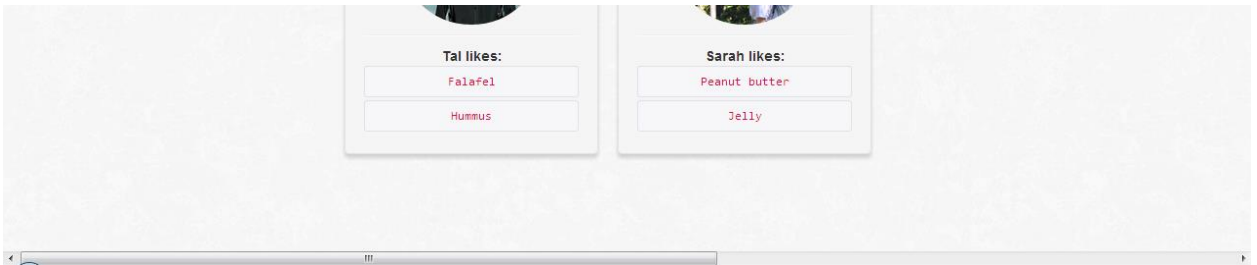
16. Arrow button stands out, but doesn't do anything different from clicking on the larger square – might even seem to be the only clickable portion.
