- The Reviewer Group Privacy Setup is a confusing page to me. I finally got it, but initially was confused towards the purpose of the separate public and private groups. Perhaps the learnability of this page could be improved
- The next page and submit button do the same thing from the Reviewer Group Privacy Setup page, while the next page link looks a little funky.
- The previous comment also applies to the add tags page
- When adding tags, it is not clear whether we need to add a hashtag before the word or not. For error handling it might be wise to strip off any pound signs and also check for multiple words since the adding is supposed to be one tag at a time.
- Related to the previous note, it might be beneficial for efficiency purposes to allow the user to enter a single line of space separated hashtags. Regardless of the method you eventually choose for your design, it should be clearly explained and the error handling should be well thought out to prevent hashtag confusion.
- After submitting my hashtags I am not sure what happened. I was redirected to a the MM picture with my hash tags in a bubble on the top left (tried to SS but closed out of it)
- Clicking on the "Logged in as <u>yourself</u>" apparently does nothing.
- I do not understand what the red outline on the boxes of the comments are supposed to tell me; Learnability
- Again for learnability, The '+' sign mouse pointer while over the image is a little
 misleading because it only drags and drops while I was expecting some sort of
 cropping or zooming function
- For efficiency purposes the edit box of comments that one posts is really tiny and only spans ~50 characters. This should be larger so you can see most of the text that you are editing.
