


## **Positives:**

1 Feedback: user is greeted by name



2 **Learnability:** clicking on help gives users tooltips and a small tutorial, which is Good helpful




3 Feedback: upload provides a preview of the picture

**Shortcut:** clicking on Description field allows user to directly type descriptions of a ghoto Good





## Negatives:


1 **Error prevention & reversible actions:** No undo and no trashcan where accidentally removed pictures can be retrieved


For example, clicking on a picture and clicking Remove Selected removes the picture in one click. If I had done that by accident, I don't know how to recover that.

- 3 User control & efficiency: pictures are not clickable on Home page Major




As a user, I would expect that the picture thumbnails are clickable. It would also increase the efficiency.

**User control:** There is no way to highlight or select a video. Usually a user can Major select an item by clicking it, but when I click on the video, the video just starts playing. If I try to click along the perimeter of the video, it doesn't do anything.



**Graphic design and Visibility:** photo is not enlarged when clicked on. User Major might not be able to see clearly.



When I double-click on a picture and a pop-in of it along with its information is displayed, I would expect that the picture be blown up within the pop-in.

**Learnability:** Not quite sure what is meant by "Spouse content to edit". Does Major this imply that there is one person in each household designated as primary account holder and the other as the spouse? However, what if other people in the house (grandparents, older siblings) want to edit?


